## MAPS, COMPASS, GPS AND AIDS FOR EMERGENCY RESPONSE

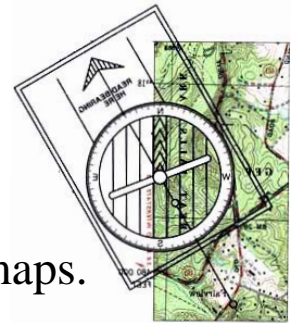
Enjoy the Back Country through the use of maps, compass, GPS and aids for Emergency Response. Don't be a statistic or lose precious time.
